Bills affecting State or local retirement systems	Tuesday, May 3	Thursday, May 19

Eligible to file in 2016, but no deadlines:

- (1) Bills amending the North Carolina Constitution
- (2) Appointments to/confirmation of members of State boards/commissions
- (3) Resolutions not prohibited by House or Senate Rules
- (4) Joint resolutions authorizing other bills (two-thirds vote required)
- (5) Election law bills
- (6) Redistricting bills for House, Senate, and Congress
- (7) Bills responding to litigation related to House, Senate and Congressional districts
- (8) Bills responding to actions related to the Voting Rights Act of 1965
- (9) Bills to disapprove Administrative Rules
- (10) Adjournment resolution sine die
