CHAPTER 1087
SENATE BILL 420

1 AN ACT RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY OF LOCAL BOARDS OF HEALTH TO
2 ACCEPT FEES.

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4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

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6 **Section 1.** G.S. 130-17 is amended by adding a new subsection thereto to be
7 designated subsection (e), and to read as follows:

8 "(e) The local boards of health are hereby authorized to enter into contracts with the
9 Veterans' Administration or any other governmental or private agency, or with any person,
10 whereby the local board of health agrees to render services to or for such agency or person in
11 exchange for a fee to cover the cost of rendering such service. This authority is to be limited to
12 services voluntarily rendered and voluntarily received, and shall not apply to services required
13 by statute, regulation, or ordinance to be rendered or received. The fees to be charged under the
14 authority of this subsection are to be based upon a plan recommended by the local health
15 director and approved by the local board of health and the State Health Director, and in no
16 event is the fee charged to exceed the cost to the health department of rendering the service.

17 "The fees collected under the authority of this subsection are to be deposited to the account
18 of the health department so that they may be expended for public health purposes in accordance
19 with the provisions of the County Fiscal Control Act. No individual employee is to receive any
20 compensation over and above his regular salary as a result of rendering services for which a fee
21 is charged."

22 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are
23 hereby repealed.

24 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its ratification.
