4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 15A-403 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
6	"(<u>d</u>) <u>The persons described below, employed as full-time law enforcement officers</u>
7	by the federal government and who are authorized to carry firearms in the performance
8	of their duties, shall be empowered to act as State law enforcement officers for the
9	purpose of the enforcement of the laws of this State and shall enjoy the same immunity,
10	if any, the same extent as certified State law enforcement officers:
11	(1) United States Secret Service special agents;
12	(2) Federal Bureau of Investigation special agents;
13	(3) Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms special agents;
14	(4) United States Naval Investigative Service;
15	(5) Drug Enforcement Administration special agents;
16	(6) United States Customs Service investigators, special agents and
17	inspectors;
18	(7) United States Postal Service inspectors;
19	(8) Internal Revenue Service special agents;
20	(9) United States Marshals Service marshals and deputies."
21	Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
