COUNCIL FOR THE ARTS IN LENOIR COUNTY.

Whereas, the Community Council for the Arts provides the citizens of Kinston and Lenoir County with access to social, cultural, and educational benefits; and Whereas the present facility in Kinston is too small to provide adequate

Whereas, the present facility in Kinston is too small to provide adequate space for arts display; and

Whereas, a vacant building known as the Midyette Hardware Store, located in downtown Kinston, is available to provide adequate space for the Community Council for the Arts after appropriate renovations; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Lenoir County \$150,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to relocate the Community Council for the Arts to the Midyette Hardware Store and to renovate the facility to accommodate the organization, provided \$600,000 in local funds are raised by the county to match this appropriation on a four-to-one basis.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
