A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE INDIVIDUAL CHILD CARE ARRANGEMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Effective October 1, 1990, the Day Care Section of the Division of Facility Services, Department of Human Resources, shall increase the rates for independent child care arrangements from the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per month per child to the market rate as determined by the Department of Human Resources per month per child on or after that date.

Sec. 2. The Day Care Section of the Division of Facility Services, Department of Human Resources, shall report to the Appropriations Committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate by March 1, 1991, on the number of children that have left subsidized day care facilities on or after October 1, 1990, and on the approximate number of new children that would likely be able to be placed in individual child care arrangements rather than in subsidized day care facilities if the rates were increased to the market rate as determined by the Department of Human Resources per child per month.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Day Care Section, Division of Facility Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of \$10,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to administer this act.

Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
