The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The corporate limits of the Town of Black Mountain are reduced by removing the following described tract:

LYING AND BEING in Black Mountain Township, Buncombe County, North Carolina:

BEGINNING at a stake marking the southwest corner of that property described as the first tract in that deed recorded in Deed Book 755 at Page 362, Buncombe County Registry; thence from said Beginning East 420 feet to a stake; thence North 1 degree 15' West 504.87 feet to a stake marking the northwest corner of a 9.7 acre tract of land conveyed to the North Carolina State Tubercular Sanitorium; thence North 88 degrees 50' West 404 feet to a point in Cragmont Road; thence along and with said road in a southerly direction for a distance of 510 feet to the point of BEGINNING,

- being approximately 4.5 acres and being all of the property of Mary C. Lyda and son, 17
- 18 Paul E. Lyda, as described in that deed recorded in Deed Book 755 at Page 362,
- 19 Buncombe County Registry.

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Sec. 2. This act shall become effective February 28, 1989.
