A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PURCHASING PROCEDURES AND CONTRACTS 3 FOR IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE TOWN OF TOPSAIL BEACH SHALL BE

4 GOVERNED BY GENERAL LAW.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 18 of the Charter of the Town of Topsail Beach, being 7 Chapter 67, Session Laws of 1963, reads as rewritten:

8 "Sec. 18. Purchase Procedure. Before making any <u>Any</u> purchase for supplies, 9 materials or equipment, opportunity shall be given for competition under such rules and 10 regulations, and with such exceptions, as the board of commissioners may prescribe by 11 ordinance. All expenditures for supplies, materials, equipment, involving more than 12 two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) shall be made on a written contract, and such contract

shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder after such public notice and
competition shall be made as is required by law in North Carolina."

15 Sec. 2. Section 19 of the Charter of the Town of Topsail Beach, being 16 Chapter 67, Session Laws of 1963, reads as rewritten:

17 "Sec. 19. Contracts for Town Improvements. Any <u>contract for</u> town improvement 18 costing more than thirty-five hundred dollars (\$3500.00) shall be executed by written 19 contract. All such contracts for more than thirty-five hundred dollars (\$3500.00) shall 20 be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder after such public notice and competition as 21 may be prescribed by law in North Carolina, provided the board of commissioners shall 22 have the power to reject all bids and advertise again. Alterations in any contract may be 23 made when authorized by the board of commissioners."

24 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
