- Section 1. G.S. 7A-273(1) reads as rewritten:
- 5 "(1) In misdemeanor <u>or infraction cases</u>, other than traffic traffic, hunting, fishing,

6 boating, and alcohol offenses, in which the maximum punishment which can be

7 adjudged cannot exceed imprisonment for 30 days, or a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00),

8 (\$50.00) or a penalty of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00), exclusive of costs, to

- 9 accept guilty pleas or admissions of responsibility and enter judgment;".
- 10 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
