A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT FOR STAFF DEVELOPMENT IN LOCAL CHILD NUTRITION
 3 PROGRAMS.
 4 Whereas, it is difficult for a hungry child to learn the basic education skills
- 5 that are essential to becoming a productive citizen in adult life; and
- 6 Whereas, these lunches are nutritionally balanced and nourish the minds and 7 bodies of young school children, the State's most valuable and important resource; Now, 8 therefore,
- 9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 10 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 11 Public Education for the 1989-90 fiscal year the sum of two hundred eighty thousand 12 dollars (\$280,000) to be allocated as follows:
- 13(1)To each local school administrative unit the sum of five hundred14dollars (\$500.00); and
- 15 (2) Of the remaining funds after the allocation specified in subdivision (1) 16 of this section, to each local school unit, an additional sum based on its 17 average daily membership; for staff development in the areas of 18 financial management, food production, meal service, and nutrition 19 education. Local school units receiving funds under this act shall 20 establish a staff development plan.
- 21 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989. The Department of 22 Public Education shall report by May 1, 1990, to the Joint Legislative Commission on

- 1 Governmental Operations and the Fiscal Research Division of the Legislative Services
- 2 Office on its progress in providing staff development for local child nutrition programs.
