CHAPTER 289 HOUSE BILL 671

AN ACT TO ALLOW MONTGOMERY COUNTY TO ESTABLISH VOTING PRECINCTS DURING 1989 WITHOUT REGARD TO TOWNSHIP BOUNDARIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 163-128, a county board of elections may divide a county into precincts for the purpose of voting without regard to township boundaries.

- Sec. 2. This act applies to Montgomery County only.
- Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification. This act expires January 1, 1990; provided, however, that any precinct changes made pursuant to this act shall remain effective.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 12th day of June, 1989.
