4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5) does not apply to the Town of Garner for
6	any noncontiguous annexation within the following area:
7	Beginning at the northern intersection of the Garner extraterritorial
8	jurisdiction (ETJ) line and the western I-40 right-of-way, moving
9	southwest to Sanderford Road, then following Creech Road to Main
10	Street in Garner, then continuing south on Rand Mill Road to its
11	intersection with N.C. 50, then continuing south on N.C. 50 to its
12	second intersection with S.R. 1010, then proceeding on S.R. 1010
13	eastwardly to the Johnston County line, then northward along the
14	Johnston County line to the jointly agreed upon Garner/Raleigh future
15	extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) line at S.R. 2512; then westward
16	along the northern boundary of the Garner extraterritorial jurisdiction
17	(ETJ) to the western edge of the I-40 right-of-way, and then northward
18	to the point of beginning.
19	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
