## CHAPTER 474 HOUSE BILL 762

## AN ACT TO ALLOW SAMPSON COUNTY TO ESTABLISH VOTING PRECINCTS WITHOUT REGARD TO TOWNSHIP BOUNDARIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 163-128, a county board of elections may divide a county into precincts, for the purpose of voting, without regard to township boundaries.

- Sec. 2. This act applies to Sampson County only.
- Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 27th day of June, 1989.
