A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A NEW BUILDING FOR THE LA3 GRANGE RESCUE SQUAD.
- 4 Whereas, volunteer rescue squads provide valuable and needed services to the 5 citizens in their districts; and
- 6 Whereas, a central place to train and maintain operations is essential for 7 volunteer rescue squads to continue to provide quality service; and
- 8 Whereas, volunteer rescue squads rarely have the time to the raise funds; 9 Now, therefore,
- 10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 11 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the La Grange 12 Rescue Squad, in Lenoir County, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 13 1989-90 fiscal year for a new building to be used as a training center and headquarters 14 facility.
