7 Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 547, Session Laws of 1989, reads as 8 rewritten:

9 "Section 1. The Director of the Budget may continue through July 15 July 28, 1989, to allocate funds for expenditure for current operations by State departments, 10 institutions and agencies at a level not to exceed the level at which those operations 11 were funded as of June 30, 1989, except as reduced by enactment of Chapter 500, 12 Session Laws of 1989, as reflected in the reports of the House Committee on 13 Appropriations, the Senate Committee on Appropriations, and the report of the 14 Committee of Conference on Senate Bill 43, 1989 Session. Nothing in this section 15 repeals any other act passed by the 1989 General Assembly appropriating funds. To the 16 extent necessary to implement this authorization, funds currently available in the 17 18 appropriate State funds and in cash balances, federal receipts, and departmental receipts shall be considered appropriated by the General Assembly." 19
