G.S. 15B-2(5) reads as rewritten: 9 'Criminally injurious conduct' means conduct that occurs or is attempted in "(5) this State which by its nature poses a substantial threat of personal injury or death, and 10 is punishable by fine or imprisonment or death, or would be so punishable but for the 11 fact that the person engaging in the conduct lacked the capacity to commit the crime 12 under the laws of this State. Criminally injurious conduct includes conduct involving 13 impaired driving as defined in G.S. 20-4.01(24a) but does not include conduct arising 14 out of the ownership, maintenance, or use of a motor vehicle when the conduct is 15 punishable only as a violation of other provisions of Chapter 20 of the General 16 Statutes." 17 Sec. 2. G.S. 15B-4 reads as rewritten: 18 19 "§ 15B-4. Award of compensation.

20 Subject to the limitations in G.S. 15B-22, compensation for criminally (a) injurious conduct shall be awarded to a claimant if substantial evidence establishes that 21
