A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SET THE 1989 MEDICAID AND AID TO

FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN INCOME ELIGIBILITY

STANDARDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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Section 1. Effective January 1, 1990, the maximum net family annual income eligibility standards for Medicaid and Aid to Families with Dependent Children, and the Standard of Need for Aid to Families with Dependent Children shall be as follows:
