A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW STUDENTS OF UNIVERSITIES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
STATE TELEPHONE NETWORK.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143-340(25) reads as rewritten:

"(25) To make the services of the State telephone network available, on a cost basis, to city and county agencies ~~the services of the State telephone network~~ and to constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina, including The North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics, for use from student telephones in residence halls or other campus facilities. These services are to be ~~charged-billed to the~~ each local governments-government, each University institution or, at the election of appropriate University officials, directly to individual student users, based on the proportional cost of maintaining and operating the system and in accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the Governor and approved by the Council of State."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
