## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A GENERAL RESERVE FUND.
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by
5	adding a new section to the end to read:
6	" <u>§ 143-34.8. General Reserve Fund.</u>
7	(a) There is established a General Reserve Fund to be used as a contingency
8	reserve for cash needs at the end of a fiscal year. It is the intent of the General
9	Assembly to appropriate to the General Reserve Funds the sum of
10	for each fiscal year in the Current Operations Appropriations Act. These funds shall be
11	deposited with the State Treasurer and invested as provided in G.S. 147-69.2 and G.S.
12	<u>147-69.3.</u>
13	(b) If the Director of the Budget determines pursuant to the provisions of G.S.
14	143-25 that the aggregate revenues collected and available during a fiscal year are not
15	sufficient to pay all of the appropriations for that fiscal year in full, he may, in his
16	discretion, transfer funds from the General Reserve Fund to pay the appropriations for
17	the fiscal year in full. If the Director of the Budget decides not to transfer the funds
18	from the General Reserve Fund as provided in this section, he shall proceed as provided
19	in G.S. 143-25 to administer the budget so as to prevent any overdraft or deficit.
20	(c) <u>Whenever a transfer has been made pursuant to subsection (b), it is the intent</u>
21	of the General Assembly to appropriate the amount of the transfer to the General
22	Reserve Fund in the Current Operations Appropriations Act for the next fiscal
23	biennium."
24	Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
