Section 1. G.S. 128-27 is amended by adding a new subsection (ff) to read: "(ff) From and after July 1, 1989, the retirement allowances to or on account of law enforcement officers and their beneficiaries whose retirement commenced on or before July 1, 1981, shall be increased by the following percentage amounts:

These allowance increases shall be calculated on the basis of the allowances payable for the month of June 1989, only for those officers and beneficiaries whose allowances commenced according to the foregoing periods so as not to be compounded with or take the place of any other increases in allowances payable on and after July 1, 1989."

Sec. 2. G.S. 135-5 is amended by adding a new subsection (pp) to read:

"(pp) From and after July 1, 1989, the retirement allowances to or on account of law enforcement officers and their beneficiaries whose retirement commenced on or before July 1, 1981, shall be increased by the same percentage amounts and under the same conditions as provided to retired local government law enforcement officers and their beneficiaries in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 128-27 (ff)."

Sec. 3. The provisions of this act shall be funded by unencumbered actuarial gains as of the December 31, 1987, actuarial valuations in the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System and the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System.

Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
