7	(1)	The Board shall issue a license to practice psychology to any applicant
8		who pays an application fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) and an additional
9		examination fee of not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00), who
10		passes a satisfactory examination in psychology, and who submits
11		evidence verified by oath and satisfactory to the Board that he:
12		a. Is at least 18 years of age;
13		b. Is of good moral character;
14		c. Has received a master's degree in psychology from an
15		accredited educational institution;
16		d. Has not within the preceding six months failed an examination
17		given by the Board.
18	(2)	The Board shall not prescribe any educational requirements other than
19		a master's degree in psychology for the initial license issued under this
20		section, but may impose continuing education requirements for
21		renewals of the license.
22	<u>(3)</u>	Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection, an applicant for
23		licensure as a practicing psychologist, who has met all requirements
24		for licensure as a practicing psychologist except passing the

1		examination at the practicing psychologist level, may be issued a
2		license as a psychological associate without having a master's degree
3		in psychology if the applicant passes the examination at the
4		psychological associate level."
