TO PERMIT The General As Section	who pays an application fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) and an additional examination fee of not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00), who passes a satisfactory examination in psychology, and who submits evidence verified by oath and satisfactory to the Board that he: a. Is at least 18 years of age;
(2)	 b. Is of good moral character; c. Has received a master's degree in psychology from an accredited educational institution; d. Has not within the preceding six months failed an examination given by the Board. The Board shall not prescribe any educational requirements other than a master's degree in psychology for the initial license issued under this section, but may impose continuing education requirements for

licensure as a practicing psychologist, who has met all requirements

1		for licensure as a practicing psychologist except passing the
