1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH 2 COMMISSION TO STUDY THE ISSUES INVOLVED IN THE EMERGENCY 3 MEDICAL SERVICES ACT OF 1973.

4 Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study issues relating to the Emergency Medical Services Act of 1973 in order to:

- (1) Determine whether the Emergency Medical Services Act of 1973 provides the State with the most feasible approach to emergency medical care;
- (2) Determine whether all residents of the State have access to high quality emergency medical services care;
- (3) Determine what impact the reduction in federal assistance has had in emergency medical care in North Carolina;
- (4) Determine whether the current structure of providing emergency medical services in North Carolina serves the public in the best, most cost-effective manner; and
- (5) Determine whether the Office of Emergency Medical Services is appropriately placed in the Division of Facility Services, Department of Human Resources.

The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report, including any legislative recommendations, to the 1989 General Assembly, Regular Session 1990, and may make a final report to the 1991 General Assembly.

Sec. 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
