A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF TOLL ROADS IN NORTH CAROLINA AND REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study the feasibility of constructing, maintaining, repairing, and operating toll roads in the State. The study shall include an analysis of the projected costs of toll roads, including costs associated with the acquisition of land, the construction of buildings and structures, the machinery and equipment that would be needed, the engineering and technical support needed, the financing of the construction and operation, and other expenses necessary or incident to toll roads. The study shall examine the findings and recommendations of the Department of Transportation in its report, "Preliminary Identification of Potential Toll Highways and Bridges in North Carolina," to the Joint Legislative Highway Oversight Committee relating to toll roads and consult with that Committee as to desirability and practicality of implementing toll roads in the State. The Legislative Research Commission shall file a report on its findings and recommendations with the General Assembly on or before the convening of the 1993 Session.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
