### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

### 2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE EXCISE TAX ON CIGARETTES FROM TWO 3 CENTS PER PACK TO TWELVE CENTS PER PACK.

- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 105-113.5 reads as rewritten:

# 6 "§ 105-113.5. Privilege tax levied.

In addition to all other taxes and fees, a tax is hereby levied upon the sale or
possession for sale within this State, by distributors, of all cigarettes at the rate of one
mill-six mills per individual cigarette.

10 The tax hereby levied shall not apply to free distribution of sample cigarettes in 11 packages containing five or fewer cigarettes nor to any package of cigarettes 12 customarily donated free of charge by manufacturers of cigarettes to employees in 13 factories where cigarettes are manufactured in this State where such packages of 14 cigarettes are not taxed by the federal government."
