A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE NONPARTISAN ELECTION OF THE
2 CARTERET COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION, SUBJECT TO A
3 REFERENDUM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of Chapter 625, 1967 Session
7 Laws, as amended by Chapter 225, 1973 Session Laws, beginning in 1994 the members
8 of the Carteret County Board of Education shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis at the
9 time of the primary election for county officers. To the extent that they do not conflict
10 with this act and that act, the elections shall be conducted in accordance with Chapters
11 115C and 163 of the General Statutes. The results of the election shall be determined
12 by the plurality method under G.S. 163-292. Vacancies on the Board of Education for
13 positions elected on a nonpartisan basis shall be filled in accordance with G.S. 115C-
14 37(f). Vacancies on the Board of Education for positions elected on a partisan basis in
15 1990 or 1992 shall be filled in accordance with G.S. 115C-37.1. This section does not
16 affect the terms of office of any person elected in 1990 or 1992 to the Carteret County
17 Board of Education. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 625, 1967 Session
18 Laws, as amended by Chapter 225, 1973 Session Laws, and G.S. 115C-37(d), beginning
19 in 1998 members elected shall take office and qualify on July 1 of the year of their
20 election, and the terms of their predecessors shall expire at that same time.

21 Sec. 2. The Carteret County Board of Elections shall conduct an election on
22 November 3, 1992, on the question of approval of this act. The question on the ballot
