A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR FIRST STEP FARM'S SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROGRAM FOR WOMEN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of four hundred forty-five thousand eight hundred eighty dollars (\$445,880) for the 1992-93 fiscal year, for the Blue Ridge Center for Mental Health, Substance Abuse, and Developmental Disabilities Services, to contract with First Step Farm of Western N.C., Inc. These funds shall be used to complete construction of and operate the regional residential substance abuse program for women.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
