A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO RAISE THE FORCE ACCOUNT LIMIT OF ANSON COUNTY.

- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 143-135 reads as rewritten:

5 "§ 143-135. Limitation of application of Article.

Except for the provisions of G.S. 143-129 requiring bids for the purchase of 6 7 apparatus, supplies, materials or equipment, this Article shall not apply to construction 8 or repair work undertaken by the State or by subdivisions of the State of North Carolina when the work is performed by duly elected officers or agents using force 9 (i) account gualified labor on the permanent payroll of the agency concerned and (ii) when 10 the total cost of the project, including without limitation all direct and indirect costs of 11 labor, services, materials, supplies and equipment, does not exceed seventy-five thousand 12 dollars (\$75,000). one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000). Such force account 13 work shall be subject to the approval of the Director of the Budget in the case of State 14 agencies, of the responsible commission, council, or board in the case of subdivisions of 15 the State. Complete and accurate records of the entire cost of such work, including 16 without limitation, all direct and indirect costs of labor, services, materials, supplies and 17 18 equipment performed and furnished in the prosecution and completion thereof, shall be maintained by such agency, commission, council or board for the inspection by the 19 general public. Construction or repair work undertaken pursuant to this section shall not 20 be divided for the purposes of evading the provisions of this Article." 21
