HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 284

Sponsors: Representatives Hasty; and Bowman.

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH
2 COMMISSION TO CONTINUE ITS STUDY OF CONSUMER PROTECTION
3 ISSUES.

4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

5 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may continue its study of
6 consumer protection issues, including those affecting the elderly. In conducting its
7 study, the Commission may consider the following:

8 (1) The feasibility of consolidating the regulatory functions of
9 occupational licensing boards pertaining to the residential construction
10 industry into a single State agency for regulation of the residential
11 construction industry;

12 (2) The need for establishment of a single State entity that would hear and
13 address consumer concerns; if such need is identified, the study shall
14 consider whether the entity should be established within an existing
15 State agency, or as a newly created State agency.

16 (3) Any other consumer protection issues the Commission deems
17 appropriate.

18 Sec. 2. If the study authorized in Section 1 of this resolution is conducted, the
19 Commission shall make a final report to the 1993 Session of the General Assembly, and
20 may make an interim report to the 1991 Session, Regular Session, 1992.

21 Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
