The fee to be paid by an applicant for an examination to determine his 11 (2) or her fitness to receive a certificate of registration as a registered 12 cosmetologist shall be ten dollars (\$10.00). twenty dollars (\$20.00). 13 The fee to be paid by an applicant for an examination to determine his 14 (3) 15 or her fitness to receive a certificate of registration as a registered manicurist shall be five dollars (\$5.00). fifteen dollars (\$15.00). 16 The license fee for a registered cosmetologist shall be thirty-three 17 (4) 18 dollars (\$33.00 (\$33.00) for three years, payable in advance. The fee for renewal of the license of a registered cosmetologist shall 19 (5) be thirty-three dollars (\$33.00) for three years, payable in advance, if 20 the license is renewed before it becomes delinquent. 2	. ,	to the renewal fee, for the renewal of a registered cosmetologist's
3		license that has become delinquent.
4	(7)	The fee for a registered apprentice or certified manicurist, which shall
5	. ,	be due on or before October 1, shall be five dollars (\$5.00).
6	(8)	All cosmetic art shops shall pay an annual fee of three dollars (\$3.00)
7		for each active booth, on or before February 1 of each year.
8	(9)	A delinquency penalty of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be paid by each
9		cosmetic art shop that does not pay the required fees by the February 1
10		deadline.
11	(10)	The fee for reissuance of an expired permit of a cosmetic art shop shall
12		be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
13	(11)	All cosmetic art schools shall pay a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00)
14		annually.
15	(12)	Applicants for licensing under G.S. 88-19 shall pay an application fee
16		of fifteen dollars (\$15.00).
17	(13)	Registered cosmetologists licensed under G.S. 88-19 shall pay
18		an annual license fee of eleven dollars (\$11.00) until the
19		year in which all other registered cosmetologist licenses are due for
20		renewal and then shall pay the fees required in subdivision (5) above.
21	(14)	A delinquency penalty of three dollars (\$3.00) shall be paid by all
22		registered cosmetologists licensed under G.S. 88-19, paying on an
23		annual basis if they do not renew their license before October 1 of that
24 25		year.
25	(15)	Apprentice cosmetologists, licensed under G.S. 88-19, shall pay an
26		annual license fee of five dollars (\$5.00) for the first year, or part of
27		the year, in addition to the application fee required by subdivision (12)
28		above.
29	(16)	All cosmetic art teachers shall be licensed by the Board and shall pay a
30		fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for that license which shall be renewed
31		every two years. The fee to be paid by an applicant for an examination
32		to determine his or her fitness to receive a Certification of Registration
33	_	as a Registered Teacher shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00)."
34		2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to fees due on or
35	after that date.
