H 1 **HOUSE BILL 46** Short Title: Special Fuels License Requirement. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Brawley; and Isenhower. Referred to: Finance. February 11, 1991 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT USERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES WEIGHING TEN THOUSAND POUNDS OR LESS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A 3 4 SPECIAL FUELS TAX LICENSE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 105-449.9 reads as rewritten: "§ 105-449.9. License required of user and user-seller. Every user, except a user whose use of fuel is limited to private passenger motor vehicles and other motor vehicles licensed under Chapter 20 at 6,000-10,000 pounds or less, and every user-seller shall obtain a license from the Secretary. When issued, a user's or a user-seller's license is effective until it is cancelled." 12 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
