assessment fee.	
The Division of Services for the Deaf and the Hard of Hearing of the Department of	
Human Resources may charge an applicant for participation in the North Carolina Interpretary Classification System Programs a fee of fifty dellars (\$50.00). Top dellars	
Interpreter Classification System Program a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00). Ten dollars	
(\$10.00) of this fee is an application fee and forty dollars (\$40.00) of this fee is an assessment fee to cover the cost of administering the Program. The fee is payable when	
an applicant applies for participation in the Program."	
Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
