5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 18B-801(b) reads as rewritten:
7	"(b) Location of Stores. – A local board may choose the location of the ABC
8	stores within its jurisdiction, subject to the approval of the Commission. No new ABC
9	store shall be approved that is less than seven miles from an existing ABC store. In
10	making its decision on a location, the Commission may consider:
11	(1) Whether the health, safety, or general welfare of the community
12	will be adversely affected; and
13	(2) Whether the citizens of the community or city in which the
14	proposed store is to be located voted for or against ABC stores in
15	the last election on the question."
16	Sec. 2. This act applies to Brunswick County only.
17	Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification and expires on July 1, 1992.
