## CHAPTER 175 HOUSE BILL 58

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE DECEMBER SEVENTH AS PEARL HARBOR REMEMBRANCE DAY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 103 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

## "§ 103-10. Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.

<u>The seventh of December of each year is designated as Pearl Harbor Remembrance</u>

<u>Day in North Carolina."</u>

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
