2	AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE TOWN OF TARBORO FROM THE TIME
3	LIMITATION IN G.S. 160A-58.2 FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF AN
4	ANNEXATION ORDINANCE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Notwithstanding the requirements of G.S. 160A-58.2, the Town of
7	Tarboro may adopt an ordinance annexing property with an effective date longer than
8	six months but not to exceed 18 months from the date that the ordinance is adopted
9	provided that:
10	(1) The deferred effective date for the annexation is requested by the
11	owner of the property to be annexed; and
12	(2) The Town Council makes a finding based upon circumstances and
13	evidence satisfactory to the Town Council that such effective date is in
14	the best interest of the Town and the affected property owner.

15 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
