## **HOUSE BILL 827**

Short Title: Penalties for Underage ABC Sales. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR PERMITTEES SELLING OR GIVING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO PERSONS UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  Section 1. G.S. 18B-302 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:  "(j) It shall be unlawful for a permittee or his employee to knowingly sell or give alcoholic beverages to any person less than 21 years old. The penalty for the first violation of this subsection shall be a suspension of the permittee's permit for not less than six months. The penalty for the second violation of this subsection shall be a suspension of the permittee's permit for not less than one year. The penalty for the third violation of this subsection shall be a permanent disqualification of that permittee from
receiving any other permits under this Chapter."  Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
