| | S. 116-11 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: |
| "(<u>10a</u>) | The Board of Governors, the State Board of Community Colleges, |
| | and the State Board of Education, in consultation with private |
| | higher education institutions defined in G.S. 116-22(1), shall plan a system to provide an exchange of information among the public |
| | schools and institutions of higher education to be implemented no |
| | later than June 30, 1995. As used in this section, 'institutions of |
| | higher education' shall mean public higher education institutions |
| | defined in G.S. 116-143.1(a)(3), and those private higher |
| | education institutions defined in G.S. 116-22(1) that choose to |
| | participate in the information exchange. The information shall |

| <u>a.</u> | The number of high school graduates who apply to, are |

| <u>b.</u> | College performance of high school graduates for the year |

| 23 | Sec. 4. G.S. 115D-5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: |
| 24 | "(a2) The State Board of Community Colleges shall comply with the provisions of |
| 25 | G.S. 116-11(10a) to plan and implement an exchange of information between the public |
| 26 | schools and the institutions of higher education in the State." |
| 27 | Sec. 5. The State Board of Education shall plan how to include the |
| 28 | information described in G.S. 116-11(10a)a. and b. in the annual report card described |
| 29 | in G.S. 115C-12(9)c1. The State Board of Education shall make an interim report on |
| 30 | progress made to include this information in the annual report card prior to December 1, |
| 31 | 1992, to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee. A final report shall be |
| 32 | submitted to the General Assembly prior to May 1, 1993. |
| 33 | Sec. 6. A joint report of progress made to develop a system to provide an |
| 34 | exchange of information shall be made to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight |
| 35 | Committee no later than February 15, 1993, and annually thereafter. |

Sec. 7. This act is effective upon ratification.

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
