A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CRITICAL SCHOOL FACILITY
NEEDS FUND TO CORRECT A DISCREPANCY IN THE MANNER IN WHICH
GRANTS FROM THE CRITICAL SCHOOL FACILITY NEEDS FUND HAVE
BEEN MADE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The General Assembly finds that when the Commission on School Facility Needs established a schedule in 1988 for making grants from the Critical School Facility Needs Fund, in accordance with G.S. 115C-489.2(b), the data, although lawful, that the Commission used to determine per capita income was not the most current data available at the time that the Commission established the schedule. As a result of discrepancies in the data, the Tyrrell County School Administrative unit was ranked 57th on the schedule instead of 32nd, and the Tyrrell County School Administrative Unit has not received the grant it would have received had the most current data been used. To remedy this problem, there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Critical School Facility Needs Fund the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for a grant for the Tyrrell County Schools.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
