#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO SPECIFY CERTAIN DUTIES OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE3 INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - Section 1. G.S. 97-77 reads as rewritten:

# 6 "§ 97-77. North Carolina Industrial Commission created; members appointed by 7 Governor; terms of office; chairman.

There is hereby created a commission to be known as the North Carolina 8 (a) Industrial Commission, consisting of three commissioners who shall devote their entire 9 time to the duties of the Commission. The Governor shall appoint the members of the 10 Commission, one for a term of two years, one for a term of four years, and one for a 11 term of six years. Upon the expiration of each term as above mentioned, the Governor 12 shall appoint a successor for a term of six years, and thereafter the term of office of each 13 14 commissioner shall be six years. Not more than one appointee shall be a person who, on account of his previous vocation, employment or affiliations, can be classed as a 15 representative of employers, and not more than one appointee shall be a person who, on 16 account of his previous vocation, employment or affiliations, can be classed as a 17 18 representative of employees.

(b) One member, to be designated by the Governor, shall act as chairman. <u>The</u>
 <u>chairman shall be the chief judicial officer of the Industrial Commission. The Chairman</u>
 <u>shall also be the chief executive officer of the Industrial Commission. Notwithstanding</u>
 <u>the provisions of this Chapter, the chairman shall have such authority as is necessary to</u>
 direct and oversee the Commission. The chairman may delegate any duties and

- responsibilities as may be deemed necessary to ensure the proper management of the
  Industrial Commission. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Chapter, Chapter 143A,
- 2 Industrial Commission. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Chapter, Chapter 143A,
- and Chapter 143B of the General Statutes, the chairman, with the approval of a majority
  of the commissioners, shall have the authority to hire or fire personnel or transfer
- 5 personnel within the Commission.
- 6 The governor may designate one vice-chairman from the remaining two
- 7 commissioners. The vice-chairman shall assume the authority herein set forth for the
- 8 chairman upon request of the chairman or in the absence of the chairman for a period of
- 9 24 hours or more. Such authority so delegated shall be relinquished by the vice-
- 10 chairman immediately upon the return of the chairman or at the chairman's request."
- 11 Section 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
