A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO PERMIT NEW HANOVER COUNTY TO PROVIDE PROCEDURES
FOR EVALUATING CONTRACTORS BY ORDINANCE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of New Hanover County and the
Wilmington City Council may, by ordinance, provide procedures for evaluating the
work performed by construction contractors on County and City capital improvement
projects and the Board of County Commissioners and the City Council may use the
evaluations as a factor in determining qualifications of contractors to bid on County and
City capital improvement projects. To implement this act, the Board of Commissioners
and the City Council may enact a prequalification ordinance which permits the
disqualification of construction contractors to bid on capital improvement projects based
on the evaluations authorized by this act. If the ordinance provides that the evaluations
are to be used to determine the qualified construction contractors, the ordinance shall
provide for a public hearing at least 10 days prior to the formal request for proposals.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
