SENATE BILL 506

Short Title: Adopt State Military Academy.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADOPT OAK RIDGE MILITARY ACADEMY AS THE OFFICIAL
STATE MILITARY ACADEMY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
section to read:

"§ 145-14. The State Military Academy.

Oak Ridge Military Academy, in Oak Ridge, North Carolina, is adopted as the
official military academy of the State of North Carolina."

Sec. 2. It is the intent of the General Assembly to give Oak Ridge Military
Academy an honorary designation as the official military academy of North Carolina. It
is not the intent of the General Assembly to establish a new State agency or educational
institution or qualify Oak Ridge Military Academy for State funds and this act confers
no liability on the State.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
