- 2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF UNMARKED LAW ENFORCEMENT CARS
- 3 FOR ROUTINE TRAFFIC STOPS AT NIGHT.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 Section 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 6 section to read:
- 7 "<u>§ 20-196.4. No routine traffic stops by unmarked law enforcement vehicles at</u>
 8 <u>night.</u>
- 9 Unmarked law enforcement vehicles shall not be used to make routine traffic stops
- 10 <u>between one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise.</u>"
- 11 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991.
