The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 115C-366 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 6 "(c) Any child who is qualified under the laws of this State for admission to a 7 public school and who has a place of residence in a local school administrative unit incident to his parent's or guardian's service in the General Assembly, other than the 9 local school administrative unit in which he is domiciled, is entitled to attend school in 10 the local school administrative unit of that residence as if he were domiciled there." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. 12
