1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, 3 HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES PREPARE A WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS PLAN AND TO REQUIRE THE DIRECTOR OF 4 THE BUDGET TO REVIEW THE PLAN IN MAKING RECOMMENDATIONS 5 TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR FUNDING OF WATER RESOURCES 6 7 DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS. 8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 9 Section 1. Article 21 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by 10 adding a new Part to read: **"PART 8A. WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.** 11 "§ 143-215.73A. Water Resources Development Plan. 12 Plan prepared. - Before 1 July in each calendar year, the Department of 13 (a) 14 Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall prepare a statewide plan for water resources development projects for a period of six years into the future. The plan shall 15 be known as the Water Resources Development Plan. If the plan differs from the Water 16 Resources Development Plan adopted for the preceding calendar year, the Department 17 shall indicate the changes and the reasons for such changes. The Department shall 18 submit the plan to the Director of the Budget for review. 19 20 Projects listed. - The plan shall list the following water resources (b)development projects based on their status as of 1 May of the year in which the plan is 21 22 prepared: 23 (1) Projects approved by the Congress of the United States.
