A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REDUCE THE STUDENT-FACULTY  
RATIO AT ALL THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY  
OF NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three million six hundred sixty thousand seven hundred dollars (\$3,660,700) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, to reduce the average student-faculty ratio at all constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina to no more than 16 to 1 beginning with the 1994-95 academic year.

(b) The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall adopt the rules necessary to implement this act.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
