A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL PAY FOR THE NONBETTERMENT RELOCATION OF SANITARY DISTRICT UTILITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 136-27.1 reads as rewritten:

"§ 136-27.1. Relocation of water and sewer lines of municipalities and nonprofit water or sewer corporations or associations.

The Department of Transportation shall pay the nonbetterment cost for the relocation of water and sewer lines, located within the existing State highway right-of-way, that are necessary to be relocated for a State highway improvement project and that are owned by: (i) a municipality with a population of 5,500 or less according to the latest decennial census; (ii) a nonprofit water or sewer association or corporation; ~~or (iii) any water or sewer system organized pursuant to Chapter 162A of the General Statutes;~~ or (iv) any sanitary district organized pursuant to Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
