A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DELETE THE CITY RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR MEMBERS
OF THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 4.61(1) of the Charter of the City of Charlotte, being Chapter 713 of the Session Laws of 1965, as rewritten by Chapter 449 of the Session Laws of 1979, reads as rewritten:

"(1) The members of the Civil Service Board ~~shall be electors of the City of Charlotte and~~ shall take an oath to faithfully perform their duties. The members of said Board shall be subject to removal from office by a two-thirds vote of the City Council, with or without cause."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
