AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING WITH THE AID OF BOATS DURING DEER

SEASON IN TOWN CREEK IN BRUNSWICK COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. It is unlawful for any person to hunt, take, or kill, or to attempt to hunt, take, or kill, deer with the aid of a boat or other floating device on Town Creek in Brunswick County. This act shall not apply to the use of Town Creek for the transportation of hunters and their legally taken game.

- Sec. 2. Violation of this act is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each violation.
- Sec. 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.
 - Sec. 4. This act applies only to Brunswick County.
- Sec. 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.
