11	"Sec. 9.85. Exemption From Certain Purchasing Requirements. The provisions
12	of G.S. 143-129, et seq., pertaining to formal bid requirements do not apply to
13	purchases by the City of Charlotte of telecommunications, data processing and data
14	communications equipment, supplies and services, regardless of the amount of such
15	purchases. The City may vary this exemption according to the type or amount of
16	purchase, and may vary as to whether the exemption is from some or all of the statutory
17	provisions."
