2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ACQUISITION AND
3	REHABILITATION OF THE TOPSAIL ISLAND ASSEMBLY BUILDING.
4	Whereas, the Topsail Island Assembly Building is an historic landmark
5	worthy of preservation based on its contributions to the nation's missile program, jet
6	engine development, and the NASA Space Program; and
7	Whereas, the Assembly Building complex is the most intact installation of its
8	kind on the east coast, and is the largest building of its kind between Wilmington and
9	Jacksonville; and
10	Whereas, the Assembly Building is eligible for listing in the National
11	Register of Historic Places; and
12	Whereas, the current owners of the Assembly Building plan to demolish the
13	building and divide the property into lots; and
14	Whereas, the Topsail Island community would like to acquire and rehabilitate
15	the Assembly Building and use it as a community center; and
16	Whereas, uses for the building include housing a permanent museum for the
17	Historical Society of Topsail Beach, and serving as an educational teaching facility for
18	oceanographic-related programs, as a meeting facility for various local and State
19	organizations, and as a facility for cultural events; and
20	Whereas, the preserving the building will also enhance tourism and create
21	new jobs in the Topsail Island area; and
22	Whereas, Topsail Beach Economic Development Council, Inc., needs State
23	funds to acquire and rehabilitate the Assembly Building; Now, therefore,
24	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

## GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Topsail Beach 2 Economic Development Council, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two hundred 3 thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year for acquisition and rehabilitation 4 of the Topsail Island Assembly Building, an historic building to be used as a community 5 center.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
