A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H CAMP PROGRAM.

Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H educational centers, or camps, are owned by the State, or deeded to North Carolina State University; and

Whereas, no appropriated funds are presently allocated for the maintenance of these facilities; and

Whereas, each year these facilities provide educational and recreational services to more than 10,000 North Carolina families; and

Whereas, these properties represent more than \$7,000,000 in capital assets contributed by citizen volunteers; and

Whereas, the North Carolina Youth Development Department at North Carolina State University must comply with mandated safety, health, and fire standards and should make accessibility improvements to meet the needs of the youth of North Carolina; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used by North Carolina State University to meet mandated safety, health, and fire standards and to make accessibility improvements at 4-H camps.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
